Washington DC – The National Black Church Initiative (NBCI) a faith-based coalition of 34,000 churches comprised of 15 denominations and 15.7 million African American churchgoers will issue 24 religious edicts addressing a multitude of phases encompassing black church life. These priority issues will include but are not limited to – knowing the Word of God, behavior of ministers, the role of Christian women in a modern age, Christian teens and their role and responsibilities, sexuality, homosexuality, the importance of marriage, Christian singles, finances, fitness and nutrition, the importance of the family, fornication, adultery, divorce and black politicians.

Rev. Evans quote: “Recently I went to the holy land and God through our Lord Jesus Christ working through the revelation of the Holy Spirit revealed to me that HE is tired of the Black Church playing with His Gospel while the black community and the world spirals into chaos and spiritual ignorance. It is time to get it together. If we abide with this Word from God then he will bless 2015. But if we refuse 2015 will be a year of reckoning for black Christians all over the world. The reason for this is that God has given us a special position of spiritual suffering and redemption because he plans to use us in a powerful way in the future, but if we fail to heed the warning of spiritual preparation during 2014, then 2015 will be a year of darkness and confusion.”

NBCI looks forward to sharing these edicts with the African American churchgoers and the broader community at large. The coming year holds a great deal of promise and purpose and NBCI leadership stands ready to continue its faith-based leadership and advocacy.
